Know Your Facts
Diaper need is the lack of a sufficient supply of diapers to keep a child clean and healthy.
Over 20,000 infants and children in the Indianapolis area lack an adequate and reliable source of diapers. To envision the scale of the issue, the number of infants affected is larger than the number of seats in Bankers Life Fieldhouse!
WIC and other public assistance programs do not provide diapers, categorizing them as "luxury items." Many families depend upon Indiana Diaper Bank and our partner agencies to meet their infant hygiene needs.
Regardless of age or size of child, 6-10 diapers are needed daily. Estimates for diaper cost are \$100 monthly and over \$1,000 annually per child.
More than one-in-three American families (36%) struggle with diaper need.
Roughly <b>three-in-four of all families surveyed (73%)</b> feel they are not being good parents when their children are left too long in a dirty diaper. One third of households in need experience feeling stressed or overwhelmed by diapering
Of families facing diaper need, nearly <b>three-in-five parents (57%)</b> miss work or school due to a lack of sufficient supply of diapers required by daycare or early learning programs. As a result, these parents miss an average of four days of work or school in a given month.
One in five families experiencing diaper need have had to choose between purchasing food or diapers.
Children left in soiled diapers for too long visit medical providers <b>four times more often</b> than children changed on a more consistent basis.
Parents are required to supply a full day of diapers for their children or the child is <b>turned away from</b> daycare programs.

### Facebook

- Remember to include the hashtag #DiaperNeed and any other relevant tags in your tweets!


